### ***New Holiday Policy***

Holiday reservations (**3 day minimum**) can be made at anytime. Due to the growing demand for these reservations **and the increasing number of last minute cancellations** we have instituted a new holiday boarding policy.

#### **All holiday reservations must be paid in full at the time the reservation is made.**

Reservations can be modified and/or cancelled if the request is made **30 days prior** to your reserved dates. However reservation dates become **locked-in and nonrefundable 30 days prior** to dates reserved.

Any additional services your pet receives during their stay such as baths or nails can be paid for upon pick-up.

A one-time holiday fee of **\$10.00** per dog will be applied when boarding over any of the dates listed on our Web site at:

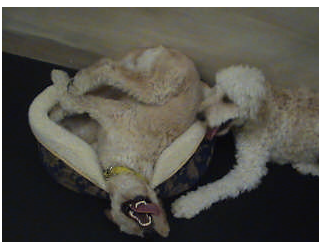

## **Tips For Boarding Your Pet**

 Make sure they are acclimated to the Paw Spa by bringing them for a few days of daycare prior to their visit. This especially applies to dogs coming for their first stay with us or if they only board once or twice per year.

 If your dog gets anxious when they sense you are leaving, try packing your bags and theirs when they are not in the room.

 Remember pets sense your body language, so do not make a big deal about having to be away from them and keep a very happy posture and tone when departing. If you fail to do so, they may interpret your body language and sadness as you abandoning them.

 When packing their bags, include only the basics such as a bed, food, treats and a few toys and make sure to label all items.

## **Did you know that Rescue Organizations exist?**

Many of our clients here at the Paw Spa have asked us about bringing a new dog into the family. We always encourage our clients to try their best to choose the right dog for their lifestyle. This means taking into account things like the breed's energy level and grooming requirements.

Many people are unaware that **rescue organizations** exist for almost every breed such as Golden Retriever Rescue, Maltese Rescue and so on. When adding a new dog to the family, we recommend checking out your local animals shelters first and foremost and, if desired, contacting a reputable breeder.

If you are looking for a specific breed and are not ready to raise a puppy, you might consider contacting your local breed rescue.

### **Rescue Mission Statement**

***“The mission of purebred rescue organizations is to re-home displaced dogs in the most appropriate environment for both the rescue dog and new owner. It is their mission to meet the needs of displaced pets, both physically, emotionally and socially, as well as educate the public of the dangers of pet store, backyard, and puppy mill purchases, health screening and training needs of the breed.”***
